Hall will be arranged in long tables and attendees will bring food to share. Raffle TBC
Free to attend for all. PA for background music. Soft drinks provided, otherwise BYOB
- **3rd December - Christmas Fair**
Stalls to be £10, 10am - 3pm
Entry £2.50 per adult which will include hot drink and a mince pie
- **17th December - Primary aged Children's Christmas Party in the hall**
Free to all Barrhill resident children, to include food and entertainer

Considerations for the future

- Following numerous complaints re: noise of fire works, cost of fireworks and how short a firework display lasts compared to the cost - Development Officer to investigate the possibility of a subsidised coach with low charge for taking residents to a local firework display
- Table top sales to be arrange indoors in 2023 following August car boot sale
- Pub style quiz to be arranged in early 2023
