

## Barrhill Activities & Attractions

2022-23 / Meeting 4 - 13 January 2023

How was the meeting advertised and what was discussed? On village notice boards, Facebook and email to all those who have opted in. Comments were also accepted by email. BAA will ask to provide the majority of the funds BDT under their objectives to provide access to sporting, cultural and art events and pastimes. Meeting was delayed from 11th due to COVID in the village

Forty (40) events were planned and a full list is attached, plus planning meetings as well as training for Barrhill people to be able to run these events safely

- Art workshops
- Organized Barrhill trips to outside events for primary kids, academy kids, adults to sports and escape rooms
- Bus provision to existing events Craft show at SEC and tattie festival etc
- Events in Barrhill: Easter, Coronation, Fireworks, Halloween, Christmas
- Theater, cinema and music events
- Fundraising events to cover small costs that cant be provided by the charity

BDT recently funded MIDAS training so BAA has access to low cost community transport, trips will rely on our trained drivers being willing to drive for each event.

Total costs for all events is £15,000 with potential to raise £4,000. The largest costs are:

Fireworks £6,000 Burns Supper £1,650

Senior Christmas Meal £1,500 (These 3 events total £9,150 of the £15,000)

## **Considerations for the future**

- Potential to bring volunteers together to provide soup on a regular basis in the hall
- Pub style quiz to be arranged in early 2023
- Investigation of film club at Girvan Library
- BAA meetings will be each 2 months and when needed in between
- Full open forum for collecting ideas for 2024 will be held in November

## Next steps to be taken

- Burns Supper 2024 to be booked in February 2023 and speakers / caterer secured
- Fireworks needs to be run and organised by BDT, volunteers can support
- Application to BDT fo funds required before any events can be booked. Including confirming that BDT will still provide the hall hire, and any staff required free of charge
